Chris Angsten and Jerry Borst went to Eagle Lake in Ontario Canada last October. Jerry caught this 50" Muskie vertical jigging a large blade bait over a deep hump. They said when things got tough trolling they had to resort to vertical jigging to catch fish. A change in lure presentation is all it takes at times to put fish in the boat. A good number of fish were caught deep trolling a JB-2 Spoonplug. This lure is can reach depths in excess of 60 feet on a reasonable length of wire line. When the fish are deep we need the right tools to get to them.
